

**MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE COMMON COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF FENNIMORE, GRANT COUNTY, WISCONSIN
HELD ON MONDAY, MARCH 24, 2008**

This meeting was called to order by Mayor Charles Stenner at 7:00 p.m. Roll call was taken with the following alderpersons answering present: Dan Bender, Dave Streif, Jon Miles, Greg Fry, Marcia Bahl, Linda Stephenson, Gerald Bollant (late) and Sara Brodt. Others present: Mike Hunt, Dave Rosemeyer, Cathy Freymiller, Correne Morgan, Mary Freymiller, Linda Parrish, Atty. Eileen Brownlee, DPW John Murphy and Clerk Margaret Sprague.

Proof in the form of a certificate of public notice given as required by Section 19.84, Wisc. Stats, as to the holding of this meeting, was presented by the Clerk. Motion by Streif second by Brodt to approve the proof of posting and agenda. Carried.

Motion by Stephenson second by Brodt to approve the minutes of the March 10, 2008, regular meeting as printed by the Clerk. Carried.

Motion by Bender second by Streif to grant an operator's license to Alissa A. Schell. Carried.

Ald. Bollant arrived at approx. 7:06 p.m.

Linda Parrish, Promotions Coordinator, gave a monthly report on activities in her office. Motion by Streif second by Brodt to approve the March Promotions Coordinator Report as presented. Carried.

Motion by Stephenson second by Bender to approve the February Treasurer's report as presented. Carried.

The council and others present discussed vandalism in the Memorial Building, unauthorized use of the Memorial Building auditorium, setting up a system to give keys to coaches who are using the auditorium during basketball season, establishing a Recreation Board, etc. Agreed that a committee meeting to establish policies regarding these matters would be appropriate.

The council discussed contributing funds toward the purchase of a waste receptacle for the Lincoln Avenue beautification project. The matter was tabled until calls are made to other possible donors.

Set a Recreation Committee meeting for Monday, March 31st at 5:30 p.m.

The Finance Committee presented claims of \$132,961.45 - General City; \$13,811.26 - Utility; \$4,305.73- Sewer; and \$40,995.38- March 14th payroll. Motion by Fry second by Streif that these bills be approved and paid by the proper officials. Upon roll call vote all alderpersons present voted aye. Carried.

Motion by Streif second by Brodt to adjourn. Carried.
