

**MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE COMMON COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF FENNIMORE, GRANT COUNTY, WISCONSIN
HELD ON MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 24, 2007**

This meeting was called to order by Mayor Charles Stenner at 7:00 p.m. Roll call was taken with the following alderpersons answering present: Marcia Bahl, Linda Stephenson, Sara Brodt, Dan Bender, Dave Streif, Jon Miles and Greg Fry. Absent: Gerald Bollant. Others present: Steve Wetter, Correne Morgan, Police Chief Rick Kreul, Promotions Coordinator Linda Parrish, Atty. Eileen Brownlee, DPW John Murphy and Clerk Margaret Sprague.

Proof in the form of a certificate of public notice given as required by Section 19.84, Wisc. Stats, as to the holding of this meeting, was presented by the Clerk. Motion by Streif second by Brodt to approve the proof of posting and agenda. Carried.

Motion by Bender second by Fry to approve the minutes of the September 10, 2007, regular meeting as printed by the Clerk. Carried.

Motion by Streif second by Brodt to grant an operator's license to Mary J. Dachelet. Carried.

Motion by Streif second by Brodt to approve the August Police Report as presented. Carried.

Motion by Brodt second by Miles to approve the September Director of Public Works Report as presented. Carried.

Linda Parrish, Promotions Coordinator, gave a monthly report on activities in her office. Motion by Streif second by Brodt to approve the September Promotions Coordinator Report as presented. Carried.

Motion by Streif second by Brodt to approve the August Treasurer's report as presented. Carried.

DPW John Murphy gave an update on activities relating to the Lincoln Avenue reconstruction project.

Clerk Margaret Sprague gave a report on activities planned for Public Power Week which will be celebrated October 7th -13th.

Steve Wetter gave a presentation on neighborhood electric vehicles including a sample ordinance to authorize them to be operated on city streets, information on state regulation of the vehicles and information on the specifications of the vehicles. He brought a unit along to allow council members to see it in operation following the meeting.

The Finance Committee presented claims of \$10,167.72 - General City; \$148,468.91 - Utility; \$12,477.59- Sewer; and \$44,418.77- September 14th payroll. Motion by Fry second by Streif that these bills be approved and paid by the proper officials. Upon roll call vote all alderpersons present voted aye. Carried.
